Gentlemen:

By this letter of application Amerada Petroleum Corporation wishes to state the following:

(a) That Amerada Petroleum Corporation J. G. Hare No. 7 located in the SW/4 of the SW/4 of Section 33, T-21-S, R-37-E was completed November 12, 1947 at a total depth of 8231'. The attached Exhibit A shows the location of this well on the Amerada Hare Lease together with the location of all offset wells.

(b) That subject well has 5-1/2" casing set at 8175' and cemented with 650 sacks of cement. The well is a shut-in gas well perforated in the Tubb zone from 6120' to 6145' and 6170' to 6205', Tubb gas pool.

(c) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the well in the following manner:

- (1) Perforate the 5-1/2" casing within the approximate interval of 5550' to 5750' in the Blinbry zone.
- (2) Set production type packer below these perforations at approximately 5760' to separate the two pay zones.
- (3) Produce the Tubb gas through the tubing and Blinbry gas through the tubing-casing annulus.

(d) That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion with gas from the Tubb and gas from the Blinbry is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.

(e) That the applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.

(f) That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.

(g) That by copy of this letter of application all offset operators are notified of the proposed dual completion.

Therefore, Amerada Petroleum Corporation requests that the Oil Conservation Commission set a certain day upon which this application may be heard and after said hearing to grant permission in order that applicant may dually complete the subject well as proposed in this application.

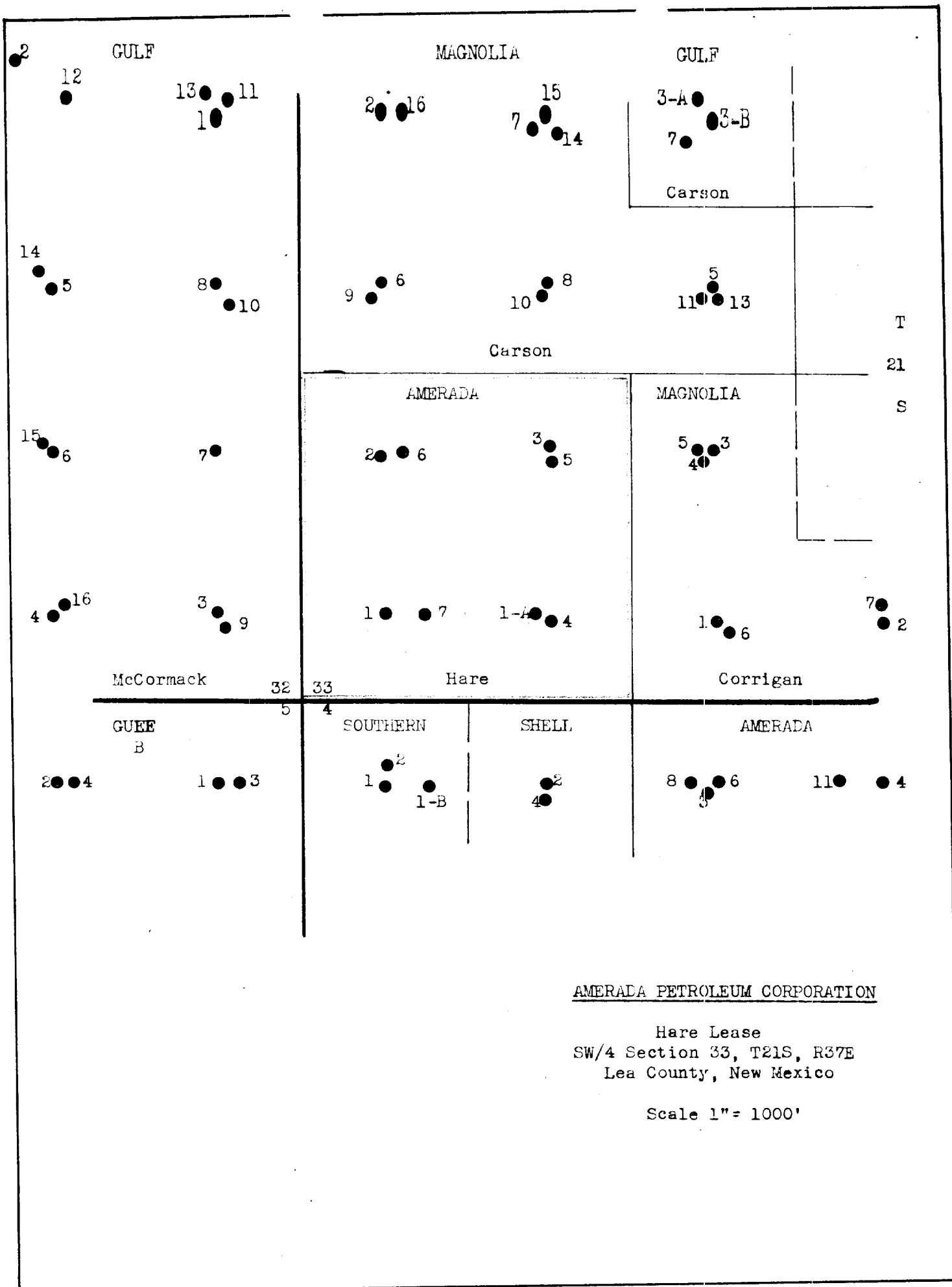
