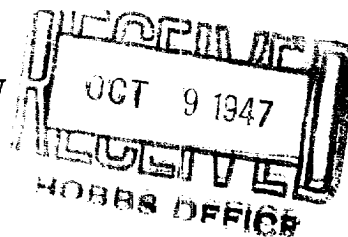

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8167' Plugged Back Depth. Acidized with 1000 gallons of Western 15% Low Tension Acid, tbgs. 2100#, csg. 2800# at start. Formation broke at 2100#. Flush of 32 bbls. oil complete at 7:02AM, 10-5-47, tbgs. 2500#, csg. 2550#. Swabbed well into pits from 8:00AM to 12 noon and recovered estimated 88 bbls. oil and acid water. Turned into tanks at 12 noon and continued swabbing. In 18 hours to 6:00AM, 10-6-47, swabbed 117.30 barrels of oil, 1/10% BS, no water, for a total of 205.30 bbls. fluid. About 27 barrels of new oil. Fluid level 1500' off bottom, csg. 200#.
