Ran American Hook Wall Packer and 265 jts. of 2" EUE, 4.7#, J-55, R-2, 8-RT SS Tubing New with 1-3' perf. nipple on bottom bull plugged and 1-8' sub on top with tubing swung at 8227' and Packer set at 8153'. Displaced mud with 35 barrels of water. Commenced swabbing and recovered fresh water.
