Picked up drill pipe, went in hole, found top of cement at 2703' and tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes and was OK. Drilled out cement to 2774' and tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes and was OK. Started drilling 7-3/8" hole at 1:30PM, August 10, 1947.
