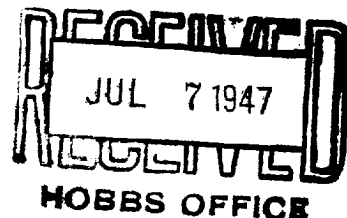

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 6:00 P.M. on June 30th, 1947, 30 hours had elapsed since running 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " O.D. casing and setting at 6603 feet, cementing with 420 sacks of cement, used as oil string.

At the time mentioned, casing shut-off was tested as follows: A pressure of 1000# was built up and held for 30 minutes. Test was O.K., and cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 1000# was built up again and held for 30 minutes. This test, too, was O.K., and drilling operations were resumed.
