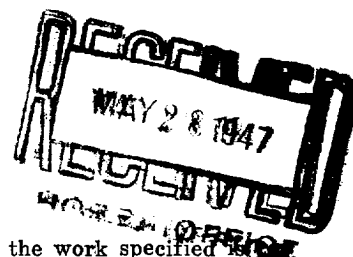

Total depth of subject well is 3750'. 7" 20# 10VT casing is set at 3614. On latest test, well produced only 2 barrels oil per day. It is proposed to deepen to approximately 6600' to test the Drinkard Section. It is anticipated that approximately 6600' of 4 1/2" OD 11.6# J-55 casing will be cemented with 150 sacks. All deeper pays will be drill stem tested. Well will be acidized as needed.
