## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Failed to get shut off on 6" Casing.

April 24, 1939 perforated 6" Casing 2474', 2449', 2424', 2399 and failed to get circulation. Perforated at 2383' cemented thru perforations with 300 sax 4% Aquagel Cement 100 Sax Neat and 200# Fibrotex.

The hole was washed down, the casing tested with 1200# pressure applied for 30 mins., the plug drilled and the hole tested with 1200# pressure applied for 30 mins., both tests were OK and after approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil & Gas inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
