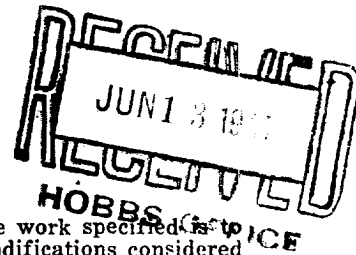

On June 10, 1947 the 7" OD 23# 8 R.T. (17 jts. A. O. Smith and 185 jts. National) Casing was set at 6495' line. Cemented with 575 sacks 2% and 125 sacks Neat Bulk Cement by Halliburton method. Plug pumped to 6446'. Job started 6:30 AM and completed at 5:30 PM. June 10, 1947.

Purpose to drill plug and test shut-off at 5:30 PM June 12, 1947.
