

The status of a bond for this well in conformance with Rule 39 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Commission is as follows:

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:

Table with 7 columns: Size of Hole, Size of Casing, Weight Per Foot, New or Second Hand, Depth, Landed or Cemented, Sacks Cement. It lists three casing strings: 17-1/4" hole with 13-3/8" casing (48# weight, 300' depth, cemented, 300 sacks), 12-1/4" hole with 9-5/8" casing (36# weight, 2900' depth, cemented, 1300 sacks), and 8-3/4" hole with 7" OD casing (23# weight, 6500' depth, cemented, 700 sacks).

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 6505 feet.
