## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well was completed July 27th, 1939 to produce from the Penrose-Skelly Pay Zone. Production at time of completion was 325 bbls. oil in 20 hrs. Present production is 3-1/2 bbls. oil.

Following is a record of casing in well:

9-5/8" OD 36# SS set at 1224' w/305 sax.  
7" OD 24# SS set at 3650' w/275 sax.

A survey will be made of the shot hole and cemented if necessary. Rotary tools will be used to drill this well deeper to an approximate depth of 6650'. A 6-1/4" hole will be drilled and 5" OD casing set on bottom and perforated opposite the Drinkard Zone.
