FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well was completed October 2, 1939 to produce from the Penrose-Skelly Pay Zone. The initial production at time of completion was estimated to be 118 bbls. oil for 10½ hrs. The present production is 3 bbls. oil per day.

Following is a record of casing in well:

9-5/8" OD 36# casg. set at 1217' w/325 sax.
7" OD 24# casg. set at 3625' w/275 sax.

A Caliper Survey will be made of the shot hole and cemented if necessary. Rotary tools will be used to drill the well deeper to an approximate depth of 6650'. A 6-1/4" hole will be drilled. 5" OD casing will be set on bottom and perforated opposite the Drinkard Pay Zone.
