Reference is made to your application dated January 27, 1992, for an unorthodox Blinebry gas well location in an existing standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) for said Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool comprising the NW/4 of Section 33, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said GPU presently has dedicated thereon the E.O. Carson Well No. 14 located in Unit C of Section 33.

By authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170 as amended, the following described well located at an unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved:

Gentlemen:

Mobil Exploration & Producing U.S. Inc. (MEPUS) as Agent for Mobil Producing Texas & New Mexico Inc., respectfully requests authority to complete the subject well in the Blinebry Gas (Blinebry) Pool at an unorthodox location under the provisions of Rule 104 (F). Well #9 is located in Unit E, 2051 feet from the north line and 589 feet from the east line of Section 33, T21S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Well #9 is presently TA'd in the Montoya Pool and Mobil now desires to plug back and recomplete the well to the Blinebry gas pool. This well violates the spacing requirements for a gas well since it is less than 660 feet from the outer boundary of the proration unit.

The following items are being submitted in triplicate, in support of this request:

- 1) Form C-101 - Application for Permit to Drill, Deepen or Plug Back;
- 2) Form C-102 - Well location and acreage dedication plat;
- 3) Map showing offset operators;
- 4) Copy of Certified letter to offset operators.
