FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well was completed September 25, 1946 to produce from the Drinkard zone; estimated oil production at time of completion was 768 bbls with a GOR of 111/1. Since completion a high GOR has developed.

Following is a record of casing in the well:

13-3/8" OD set @ 328' w/200 sax.
 9-5/8" OD set @ 3792' w/1050 sax.
 7" OD set @ 6630' w/450 sax.

It is the Magnolia's intention to squeeze cement perforations in the 7" OD casing, 6529-6540; 6551-6587; 6594-6601, and to drill this well deeper w/rotary tools to an approximate depth of 8175' to test the Ellenberger lime. A 6 1/4" hole will be drilled and 5" OD casing set on bottom and perforated opposite the Ellenberger section.
