Gentlemen:

Enclosed are original and one copy of Gas Well Plate on the E.  
Corrigan Number 7 gas well in the SE/4, Sec. 33 - 21S-37E, a  
dual completion in the Tubbs and Blinckley formations Lea County,  
New Mexico. The former unit of 120 acres, consisting of the NW/4,  
the SW/4, the NE/4 of the SE/4, has been increased to include the  
NE/4 of the SE/4 of Sec. 33. A unitization agreement to include  
this acreage has been made between Stanolind Oil and Gas Company  
and Magnolia Petroleum Company. This unitization agreement is  
retroactive to 7 A. M., November 25, 1953.

We therefore request that the well in both the Tubbs and Blinckley  
formation be given an allowable based on 160 acres instead of the  
previous 120 acres.
