## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 9:00 AM on March 13, 36 hours had elapsed since running 13-3/8" casing and setting at 298', cementing with 280 sacks to be used as surface string. At this time, casing shut-off will be tested as follows:

A pressure of 750# will be built up and held for thirty minutes, and if test is OK, cement plug will be drilled and a pressure of 750# again built up and held for thirty minutes. If this test, too, is OK, drilling operations will be resumed.
