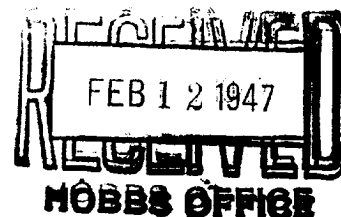

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On February 7, at 3:00 PM, 48 hours had elapsed since setting 6614 ft. of 5" 20# Grade J-55 casing in subject well and cementing with 160 sacks. At this time, casing shut-off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 1000 lbs was built up and held for thirty minutes, and as shut-off tested OK, cement plug was drilled out to 6602, and a pressure of 1000# again built-up and held for thirty minutes. As this test, too, was OK, completion operations were resumed.
