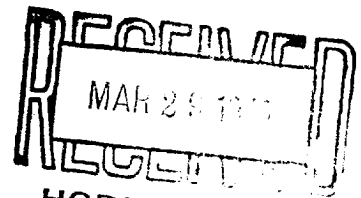

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On March 24 at 9:00 PM, 48 hours had elapsed since setting 6595 ft. of 5" OD 15# New Casing and cementing with 160 sacks. At this time, casing shut-off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 750 lbs. was built up and held for thirty minutes, and as shut-off tested OK, cement plug was drilled to 6593 ft. and a pressure of 750 lbs. again built up and held for thirty minutes. As this test, too, was OK completion operations were resumed.
