Dear Mr. Sexton,

We are in receipt of your May 12th, 1993 letter requesting a Packer Leakage Test on the subject well (copy attached).

At one time, this well was dually completed in the Blinebry and Drinkard Horizons (the Blinebry was producing up the tubing-casing annulus and the Drinkard was producing up the tubing). As per the attached Form C-103 and accompanying wellbore sketch, on July 14, 1966, the Drinkard zone was shut-in by setting a tubing stop above the Drinkard perforations. The tubing was then perforated in order that we could produce the Blinebry up the tubing. On completion of this work, future Packer Leakage Tests became unnecessary.

Given the above information, Amoco respectfully requests an exemption to all future Packer Leakage Tests on this well.
