DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On February 17th, at 5:00 PM, 48 hours had elapsed since setting 6599 ft. of 5" 20# J-55 Casing and cementing with 160 sacks. At this time, casing shut-off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 1000# was built up and held for thirty minutes, and as shut-off tested OK, cement plug was drilled to 6597, and a pressure of 1000# again built up and held for thirty minutes. As this test, too, was OK, completion operations were resumed.
