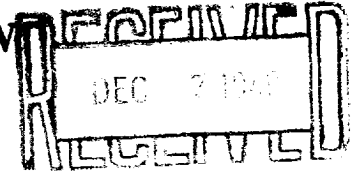

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On November 28, 1949, at 10 p.m. 48 hours had elapsed since running 5326' of 5½" casing set at 5333 and cemented with 250 sacks to be used as oil string. Pipe and water shut off was tested by applying 1000psi pressure and holding for 30 minutes before drilling cement plug. Cement plug was then drilled to 5328' and 1000 psi applied for 30 minutes. No pressure drop occurred on either test. Operations were resumed.
