FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On November 28, 1949, at 10:00 p.m., 48 hours will have elapsed since running 5326' of 5-1/2" casing set at 5333' and cemented with 250 sacks to be used as oil string. Pipe and water shut off will be tested by applying 1000 psi pressure and holding for 30 minutes before and after drilling cement plug. If pressure drop in excess of 100 psi occurs on either test proper remedial measures will be carried out. If tests are satisfactory, operations will be resumed.
