## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On November 9, 1949, at 9:45 a.m., 48 hours had elapsed since running 2906' of 7-5/8" casing set at 2898' and cemented with 1500 sacks to be used as intermediate string. Cement was circulated to surface. Pipe and water shut off was tested by applying 1000 psi pressure and holding for 30 minutes before and after drilling cement plug. Pressure drop did not occur on either test. Drilling was resumed.
