On November 1, 1949 at 10 o'clock p.m. 48 hours will have elapsed since running 320' of 10-3/4" casing set at 307' and cemented with 275 sacks to be used as surface string. Cement will be circulated to surface. Pipe and water shut off will be tested by applying 1000 psi pressure and allowing one hour to elapse before and after drilling cement plug. If pressure drop in excess of 100 psi occurs on either test proper remedial measures will be carried out. If tests are satisfactory drilling will be resumed.
