#### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On September 24, 1946, outside gas from the Eunice Gas System was connected to the well, the gas being injected directly into the casing.

Production before: Flow 76 barrels oil in 12 hours through 1/2" choke, and died.

Production after: Flow 155 barrels oil through 3/4" choke in 24 hours, with outside gas from Eunice Gas System.
