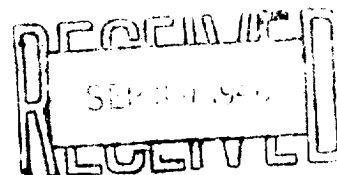

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Acidized Aug. 30, 1946, with 5000 gal. by Chemical Process. Production before, in 24 hours flowed 157 bbl oil out 4% wtr. through 3/4" choke; production after, in 14 hours flow 180 bbls. oil through 3/4" choke.

Acidized Sept. 13, 1946, with 1000 gallons by Chemical Process. Production before, flowed 180 bbl. oil in 14 hours through 3/4" choke; production after, flow 76 barrels oil in 12 hours through 1/2" choke, and died.
