DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Shot well with 180 qts. solidified nitro glycerine from 3660' to 3730' in lime formation. Tamped shot with gravel to prevent damage to casing seat. Cleaned well to bottom, set liner on bottom and set 2" tubing at 3698'. Well flowed at rate of 72 bbls. per day with gas-oil ratio of 1387 to 1.

Through over-sight, this report was not submitted at time this work was done. However, it was reported in our Mr. H. S. McGarry's letter of June 28, 1939.
