Humble Oil and Refining Company respectfully requests administrative approval to dual complete its F. F. Hardison "B" No. 2 as a Elinebry oil-Tubb gas well, Lea County, New Mexico, located in Unit A, Section 34, T-21-S, R-37-E.

This well is presently classified as a Drinkard oil-Tubb gas dual. The Drinkard is no longer capable of commercial production and it is proposed to squeeze off this zone and dually complete this well in such a manner as to permit the Tubb gas and Elinebry oil to be produced through parallel strings of 1-1/2-inch tubing as shown on the attached sketch.
