Dear Randy:

Humble has asked administrative approval of a two-well proration unit as shown in the attached application. It has been decided that no such approval is necessary and that all that must be done to dedicate two wells to a unit is file a plat showing both wells - provided that each well is a standard location for the full amount of acreage in the unit. While this is not the case in this unit, the old No. 1 Well, the original unit well, is a nonstandard location but has been accepted for years as standard \mathbf{q} . The new unit well, No. 2, is a standard location. Therefore, either well could be assigned the full allowable and by dedicating the units allowable to both wells, no harm is done.

We advised Buck Heald to file such a plat when he was in Santa Fe the other day. I suppose if you want to, you could accept the attached plats and nothing further would be necessary.

I hear you all had some snow last night - some weather, huh?
