FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK (FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Owen No. 3 was completed as an oil well in the Drinkard Pool. It is proposed to dually complete this well as a Blinbry gas well by killing the well with oil; setting a Baker Production Packer at approximately 6325'; filling hole with mud and perforate with 2 jet shots per foot from 5535' to 5690' in the Blinbry; and run tubing set in packer and complete. The well will be acidized if necessary.

Formal application to dually complete this well has been submitted to the Oil Conservation Commission.

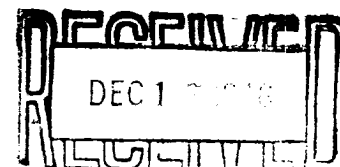
