M. Lockhart B-35 No. 2</u> well, located <u>660</u> feet from the <u>North</u> <u>line and 1,980</u> feet from the <u>East</u> line of Section <u>35</u>, T.<u>215</u>, R.<u>37E</u>, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, in the <u>Drinkard</u> <u>Oil Poel and the Blinebry</u> Gas Pool, and in support thereof would show the following:

The proposed gas unit contains <u>160</u> acres consisting of contiguous quarter quarter sections.

The dual completion of said well in the Drinkard Formation for oil and the Blinebry Formation for gas is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.

Segregation of the producing intervals will be made by appropriate packer installation and said well will be couldpad so there can be no comingling of well fluids in producing the gas through the annulus between the tubing and casing, and the oil through the tubing.
