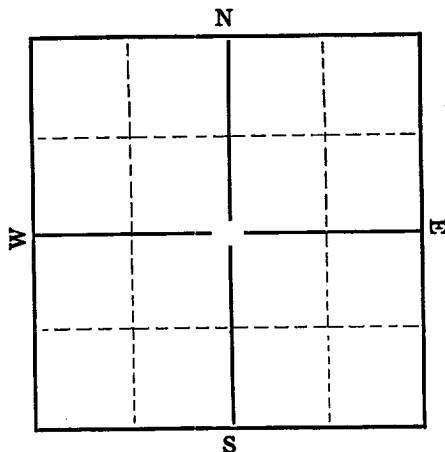

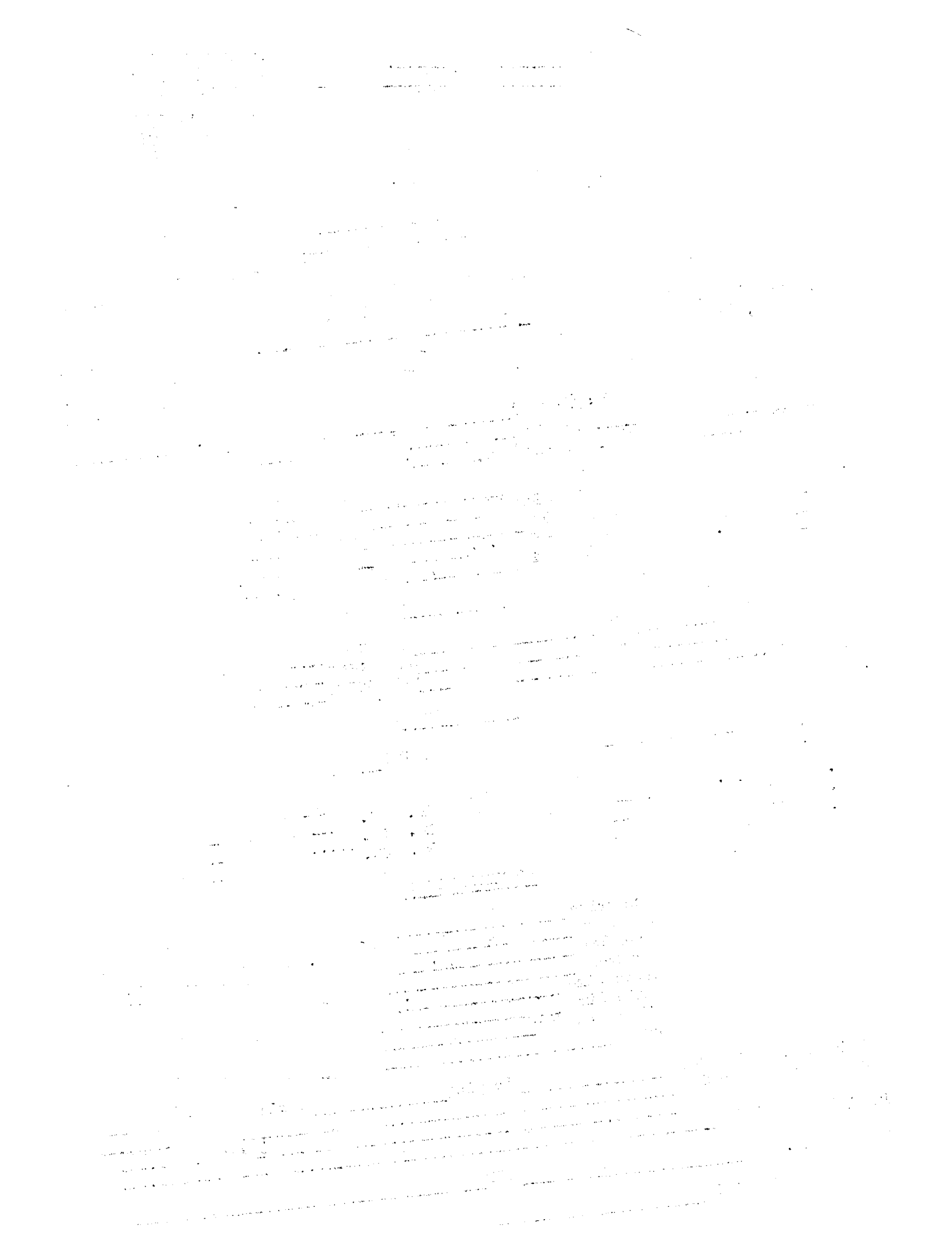

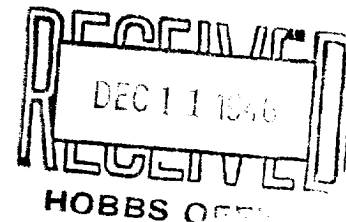

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Set 5-1/2" OD casing at 6,530' and cemented with 500 sacks. On December 2nd casing was tested with 1200# pressure and allowed to stand for 30 minutes and test was OK. Cement was drilled out to 6528', and casing was perforated from 6490' to 6470' and from 6528' to 6500' with 6 shots per ft., 15/32" holes. Acidized with 2,000 gallons acid, by Dowell, Inc., from 6528' to 6500'.

On potential test well flowed 278 bbls of oil, out 1/10 of 1% B.S. Gas-oil ratio 1416/1

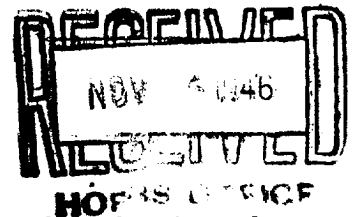
