DETAILS OF WORK

The last acid treatment consisting of two thousand gallons resulted in no increase in oil but a noticeable increase in gas. The well will now flow by agitation an average of approx. 10 bbl/day. We are preparing to give well a butane-xerolene wash and re-treat with 4000 gallons of acid.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
