## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On December 18, 1948, at 12:00 midnight, 30 hours had elapsed since running 6887' of 5-1/2" new casing in subject well and cementing with 200 sacks to be used as oil string. At this time casing shut off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 1000# was built up and held for 30 minutes, testing OK. Cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 1000# was again built up and held for 30 minutes. This, too, tested OK. Drilling operations were resumed.
