June 30, 1956; Went in hole with drill pipe, condition hole, to 4207', Total Depth. Ran 5-1/2" Liner from 3670' to 4200', Liner hung with Brown Tool Company Hanger. Cemented with 200 sacks cement, 50-50 Posmix, 2% Gel. Cement circulated around liner. Waited 24 Hours and put 1500# pump pressure on casing and liner. No loss in pressure. Now W. O. C. Will release Rotary drilling rig and rig up Double Drum Unit to perforate and complete.
