DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Byers #4 was drilled to a total depth of 9215' in McKee Sand. Ran 9167.90' (276 2/3 jts) of 5 1/2" OD 17# & 15.5# SS Csg. set at 9181' and cemented with 500 sacks of which 300 sacks contained 4# gel and 200 sacks was neat on bottom. Plug down at 5:20 A.M. 6-27-53. Cement was allowed to set 48 hours, 1000# pressure was applied for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure, test was satisfactory.
