DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 9938'. Placed solid cement plug from Total depth 9938' back to 4200'. This is approximately 100' above 7" casing shoe. 75 sacks of cement were put at 3300' in the 7" casing. A 50 sack cement plug was placed from 2650' to 2550', 50 sacks of cement were placed from 1900' to 1800', 50 sacks of cement were placed from 1400' to 300', 50' of cement was placed from 50' back to surface. Location is marked with 4-1/2" pipe 6' high filled with cement as a permanent marker. Casing was pulled by Hobbs Pipe and Supply Co., Hobbs, New Mexico, Cementing was done through tubing by BJ Cementing Company, Hobbs, New Mexico. Recovered 2610' of 7" casing, 1018' of 9-5/8" casing, 13-3/8" casing left in hole cemented. This well is now plugged and abandoned.
