DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 3:00 P. M., May 20, 1951, 90 hours after cementing the 9-5/8" casing at 3855' with 630 sacks 8% gel and 100 sacks neat cement, the casing was tested with 1,000 psi for 30 minutes before drilling the cement and after drilling the cement plug. No pressure drops were recorded and drilling has been resumed.

Temperature survey indicated top of cement to be at 2500'.
