DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 11:59 A. M. April 18, 1951, 24 hours after the 13-3/8" casing was cemented at 333', the casing was tested with 550 psi for 30 min. prior to drilling the plug. No pressure drop occurred.

After drilling the plug, the casing was tested with 500 psi. At the end of 30 minutes, the pressure remained constant.

The test was considered satisfactory and drilling has been resumed.
