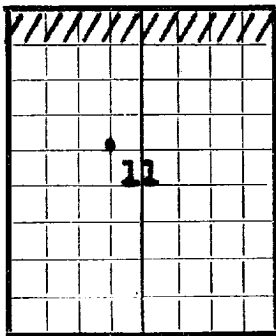

Additional information: *In the event the San-Andres is found to be non-productive, the 9-5/8" casing will be cemented at 3850' with 100 sacks neat and 630 sacks of 8% Gel.
