## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On February 15, 1951, the 7-5/8" casing in the well prior to deepening was tested with 1140 psi for 30 minutes above a packer at 4250'. No drop in pressure occurred. The test was considered satisfactory.

At 9:30 A. M. on February 17, 1951, 2826' of 5-1/2" liner was cemented from 7032' to 4206' with 100 sacks neat and 200 sacks 8% gel cement. Approx. 75 sx. of cement were circulated out above top of the liner.

At 9:30 P. M., February 19, 1951, 48 hours will have elapsed since the cementing of the 5-1/2" liner. At this time, it is planned to test casing with 1000 psi for 30 minutes before drilling the plug.

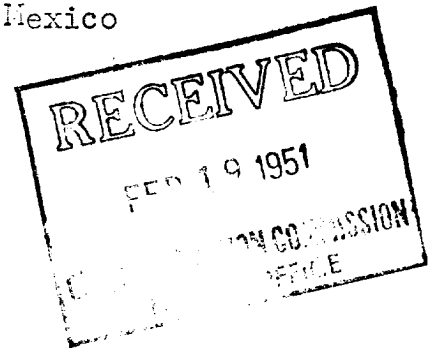
