OIL & GAS INSPECTION

RULE 1112. REQUEST FOR ALLOWABLE (FORM C - 104)

It is necessary that this form be submitted by the operators before an initial allowable will be assigned to any completed oil well. C - 110 " Certificate of Compliance " will not be approved until C - 104 is filed with the Commission. Form C-104 is to be submitted in triplicate to the Commission Office, to which Form C-101 was sent. Two copies will be retained there and the other submitted to the Proration Office, Hobbs, New Mexico. The allowable will be assigned effective 7:00 A. M., on date of completion. The completion date shall be that date in the case of an oil well, when oil is delivered into the stock tanks.
