On April 1, 1950 at 6:10 A. M., 48 hours will have elapsed since cementing 13-3/8" casing at 318' with 400 sacks cement. Cement circulated to the surface. Pipe and water shut-off will be tested before and after drilling shoe with 1000 psi for 30 minutes.

In the event a satisfactory shut-off is not obtained, adequate remedial measures will be taken. If tests are satisfactory, drilling will be resumed.
