The well was spudded at 3:00 A. M. July 29, 1950.

On July 31, 1950 at 7:00 P. M., 30 hours will have elapsed since cementing the 10-3/4" casing at 320' with 250 sacks cement. The cement circulated to surface.

At that time pipe and water shut-off will be tested with approximately 500 psi for 30 minutes before and after drilling the cement plug.

If satisfactory tests are obtained, drilling will be resumed. In the event of an unsatisfactory test, remedial work will be performed.
