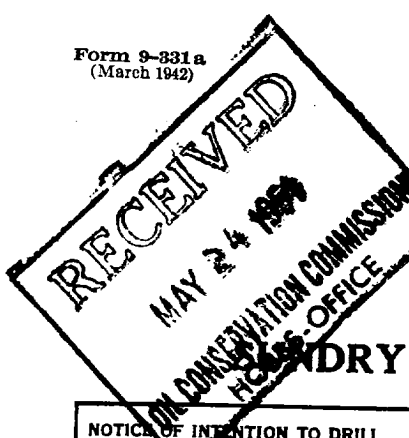

DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill a well at above location to a depth of approximately 3700' with rotary tools, and to drill thru pay zone to a total depth of approximately 3900' with reverse circulation rig. It is proposed to shoot the pay with approximately 250 qts. SNG and clean out after shot to total depth. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U.S. Geological Survey and any other special requirements will be complied with.

It is planned to use the following casing pattern: 7 5/8" casing to be set at approximately 250' and cemented with 250 sac, cement to be circulated to surface. 7" casing to be set at approximately 3700' and cemented with approximately 1640 sac, or sufficient cement to protect the salt section.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
