DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudlogging jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

It is our intention to drill a well at the above location to a depth of approximately 3720' with rotary tools and from 3720' to a total depth of approximately 3960' with reverse circulation tools. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U. S. Geological Survey and any other special requirements will be complied with. It is proposed to test interval and shoot the plug if necessary.

It is proposed to use the following casing patterns: 10 3/4" casing to be set at approximately 250' and cemented with 250 sacks cement to be circulated; 5 1/2" casing to be set at approximately 3720' and cemented with 1970 sacks cement or sufficient cement to protect the salt section.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
