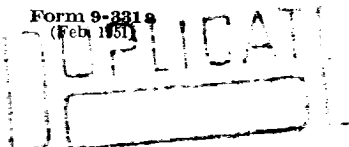

On 7-14-51, after 48 hrs. WOC, tested casing with 1000# for 30 mins. before drilling plug, final pressure 990#. Drilled out plug and tested casing with 1000# for 30 mins., final pressure 985#.
