DETAILS OF WORK

Set 10 3/4" casing at 243' and cemented with 200 sacks. Cement circulated. Total depth of hole 257' in Red Bed. Plug down 9:00 P.M. 8-18-50.

After 24 hours IOC tested casing with 250' for 30 minutes. Final pressure 230%. Found top of cement plug at 195'. Drilled plug and tested casing with 250' for 30 minutes. Final pressure 225%.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
