DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At TD 3530', 3525' 5½" casing were run and cemented with 200 sacks. Halliburton ran cement which set 72 hours and tested 1100# pressure. Drilling continued to total depth 3790' at which depth the well was swabbed once and kicked off. Well flowed average barrels of oil per hour for 12 hours with 200,000 gas through 1" of 2" tubing.
