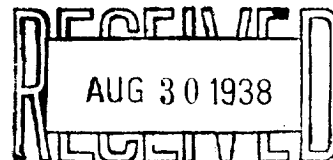

Well spudded August 24th and 283' of 7 5/8", 26# pipe set with 175 sacks of cement, giving circulation to cellar. Heavy mud was circulated before cementing. Halliburton method used. Pipe tested 800# pressure.
