DETAILS OF WORK

Plugging operations were started on this well on 8-8-37 and were completed on 8-10-37. The work was performed as follows:

A cement plug was set from the total depth, 4842', to approximately 4565 and the hole was filled with 12# mud to 2850'. A cement plug was set thru the base of the salt from 2850 to 2740 and the hole filled with 12# mud to 1670. A cement plug was set from 1670 to 1560 (9-5/8" set at 1648') and the 9-5/8" casing shot off at approximately 200'. The hole was filled from 1560 to 220 feet with 12# mud and a cement plug set from 220 to 120'. The hole was filled from 120' to 20' below the surface with 12# mud and cemented from there to the surface. The cellar was filled and a 4" marker erected according to government regulations. Pits were filled and the location was restored to its original condition.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
